TERMS OF PERMIT:

1. Permittee agrees to defend, indemnify and save Douglas County, its agents, and employees harmless from any losses, claims, expenses, judgements or other damages resulting from injury to any person or damage to property, of whatsoever nature, arising out of or incident to this permit.
2. Permittee shall, at his/her own expense, at all times during the term of this permit, maintain in force general liability insurance, automobile liability insurance and workers' compensation insurance. **Permittee shall initial one of the following:**
 1. Permittee is a business with employees and shall provide certificates of insurance for general liability, auto and workers' comp.
 2. Permittee is a business with no employees and shall provide certificates of insurance for general liability and auto.
 3. Permittee is not a business and shall provide proof of auto insurance.
3. Permittee represents by signing below that the vehicle/trailer indicated above is equipped with an actual tilting bed where operation of tilting is conducted in the vehicle cab or side such that the operator is not required to be at the rear of the vehicle near the open bin.
4. Permittee represents by signing below that he/she and his/her employees who use this permit have inspected the transfer site indicated above, that they are aware of the risks and dangers involved in dumping while the gates to the bin are open, and that a slip, fall, loss of balance, or other mishap, including unanticipated or unexpected dangers, could occur while the gates are open. Permittee and his/her employees assume all risk of injury to them, their person or property which might be sustained in connection with the use of the transfer site while the bin gates are open.
5. Permittee and his/her employees, for himself/herself and themselves, their heirs, administrators and assigns release and discharge Douglas County, its agents and employees, from all claims, demands, actions and causes of actions of any kind for injuries sustained to person or property while using the transfer site.
6. Permittee acknowledges that **disposal at transfer stations is limited to 5 cubic yards per day**. Disposal of larger quantities must be made at the Roseburg Landfill.
7. Permittee acknowledges that **the following wastes are prohibited from disposal into the bins at transfer stations: concrete chunks, rock, gravel, sand, soil, tree stumps or any heavy object which, if dumped into a bin, is capable of causing damage.**
8. This permit is revocable at any time by County for permittee's failure to abide by terms of permit.

Permittee for himself/herself and his/her employees fully understands and agrees to the terms set forth above.
