## **Offices Open during the May 21, 2024, Primary Election**

Though the May 2024 Election is eight months away, the filing period will open soon. The following is a list of public offices for which the filing officer (*see below for which one*) will accept declarations of candidacy or petitions for nomination or election for the Primary Election of May 21, 2024. The earliest day to file for the following positions is September 14, 2023, and the deadline is not later than 5:00 PM on March 12, 2024. September 14, 2023 is the deadline for candidates to be registered as a member of a major political to run for partisan office at the May Primary Election in May 2024 and to meet the 180-day membership requirement.
