

Douglas County Weed Advisory Board

Duties of the committee:

- Relay noxious weed management issues and needs identified by the Douglas County Weed Advisory Board to the County Commissioners by the County Representative or the Board Chair.
- Assist in identifying and monitoring noxious weed problem areas.
- Meet quarterly to discuss and develop strategies to support noxious weed control programs in the County.
- Maintain an updated “County Noxious Weed List”.
- Work with agencies and organizations to encourage, establish and maintain effective noxious weed control programs for Douglas County.
- Help agencies and organizations secure grant funding for noxious weed control programs in Douglas County.
- Promote public awareness of and education about noxious weed problems, identification, and control methods.
