This vessel is declared a derelict vessel for the reason of:

**DECLINING CONDITION AND DETERIORATION OF BOAT DUE TO YEARS OF
NEGLECT.**

This vessel is declared an abandon vessel by reason of:

**MULTIPLE ATTEMPTS TO NOTIFY OWNER WITH NO RESPONSE. NO PAYMENT
SINCE 2017. EXPIRED OREGON STATE MARINE BOARD TAGS OF 2018.**

This vessel **WILL BE SEIZED** by the enforcement agency, for being a derelict and/or abandoned vessel if the derelict condition of the vessel is not remedied and the vessel is not moved to a place where it can be lawfully kept by:

SEIZURE DATE / TIME: NOVEMBER 2, 2020 AT 3:00 PM.

If the vessel is seized, the owner of the vessel is liable for the salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs of this vessel. If the owner does not pay the salvage, towing and storage costs, title to this vessel will vest with the enforcement agency and the vessel will be sold or destroyed. The owner will remain liable for any outstanding salvage, towing, storage and disposal.

The owner of this vessel has until the seizure date and time above to request a hearing to contest the validity of the proposed seizer. A request for hearing must be in writing directed to the Enforcement Agency listed above, and must indicate if the owner contends that the vessel is not abandoned or derelict, or indicate such other specific grounds on which seizure of the vessel is challenged.

The owner of this vessel may be cited for possession of a derelict vessel if the owner fails to remedy the derelict condition of the vessel by the seizure date and time above.

The owner of this vessel may be cited for failure to remove an abandoned vessel if the owner fails to move the vessel to a place where the vessel can be lawfully kept by the seizure date and time above.
